



COVID-19 RIGHT-OF-WAY RESPONSE SUMMARY

- Protect our employees, customers, and the public from COVID-19 using the best known guidelines available and without violating worker rights
- Management and oversight by the YAK ACCESS COVID-19 Ops Team
- YAK ACCESS guidelines should be considered the minimum guidelines. The most stringent policies of each project customer shall be enforced on each respective customer's property or ROW
- All non-essential travel has been eliminated
- Set up social distancing for all crew to crew contact and site meetings
- All exposure control practices will be employed. Each project will be supplied with hand cleaning stations, complete COVID-19 PPE, disinfectant supplies, non-contact infrared thermometers, hand sanitizer and face masks
- Immediate tracking of all YAK ACCESS crew members
- Each crew member is checked multiple times daily by Field Management for fitness of duty and overall health using the Employee Check form
- On project, display of symptoms has crew member removed from project immediately
- Immediate cleaning and disinfecting of all tools and equipment in contact by crew team member with symptoms
- Conduct contact tracing immediately
- Immediate *"Take Out of Service"* for all tools & equipment of touched surfaces until deep clean is complete
- COVID – 19 Ops Team builds a specific risk assessment and action plan using latest CDC Guidelines
- Monitor all crew member travel activities from another city, state, or country, whether personal or business
- An affected crew member will not be allowed to return to work until evaluated and approved by the COVID-19 Ops Team
- All technology and systems are accessible and operable via remote access to ensure business continuity
